

VPN Connection LION for Mac with DUO

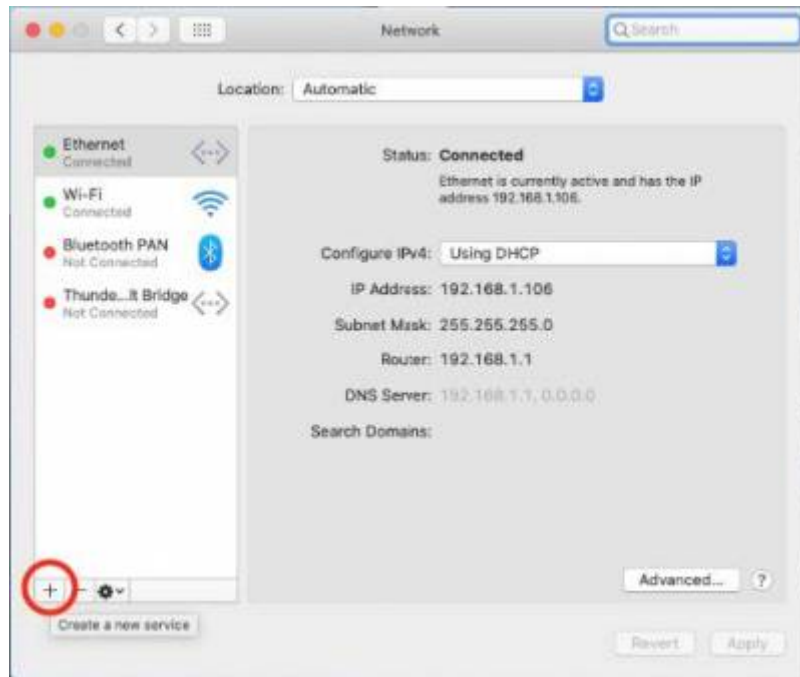
Click on System Preferences...



Click on Network



Click on +



Select in the Interface: pulldown list VPN

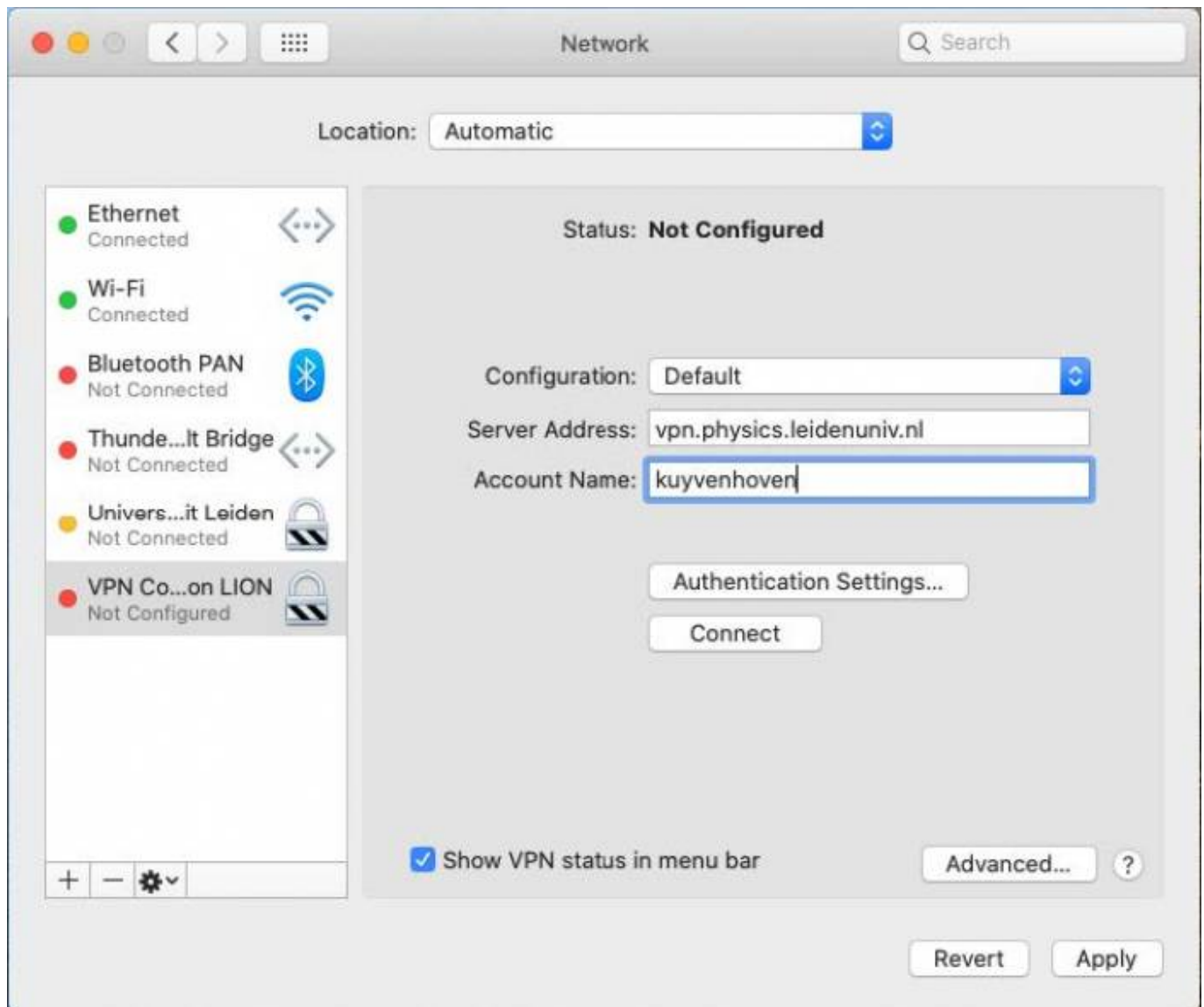
And in the VPN Type: pulldown list L2TP over IPSec

Service Name: VPN Connection LION



Click on Create

Click on Authentication Settings...



Leave Password field empty

And type the shared Secret you received in your mail.

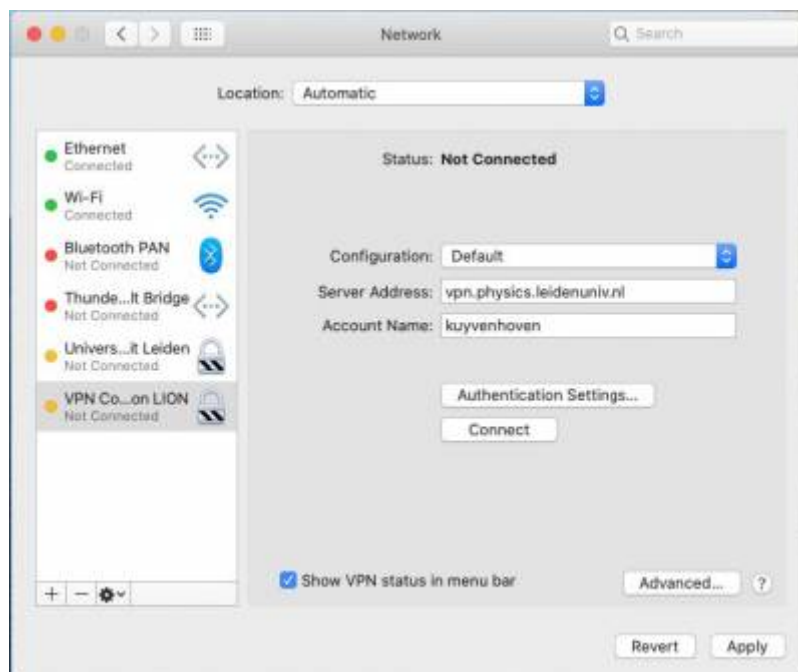

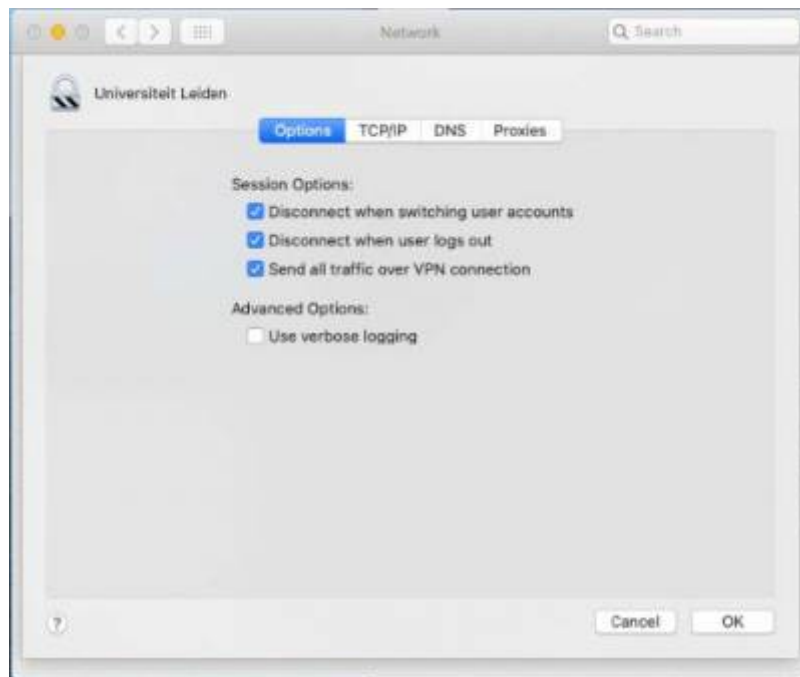

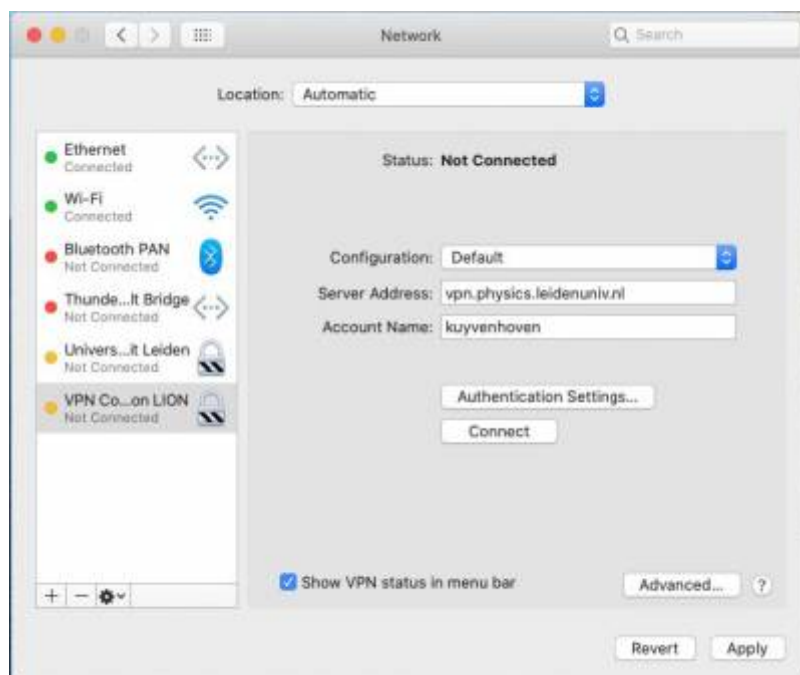
