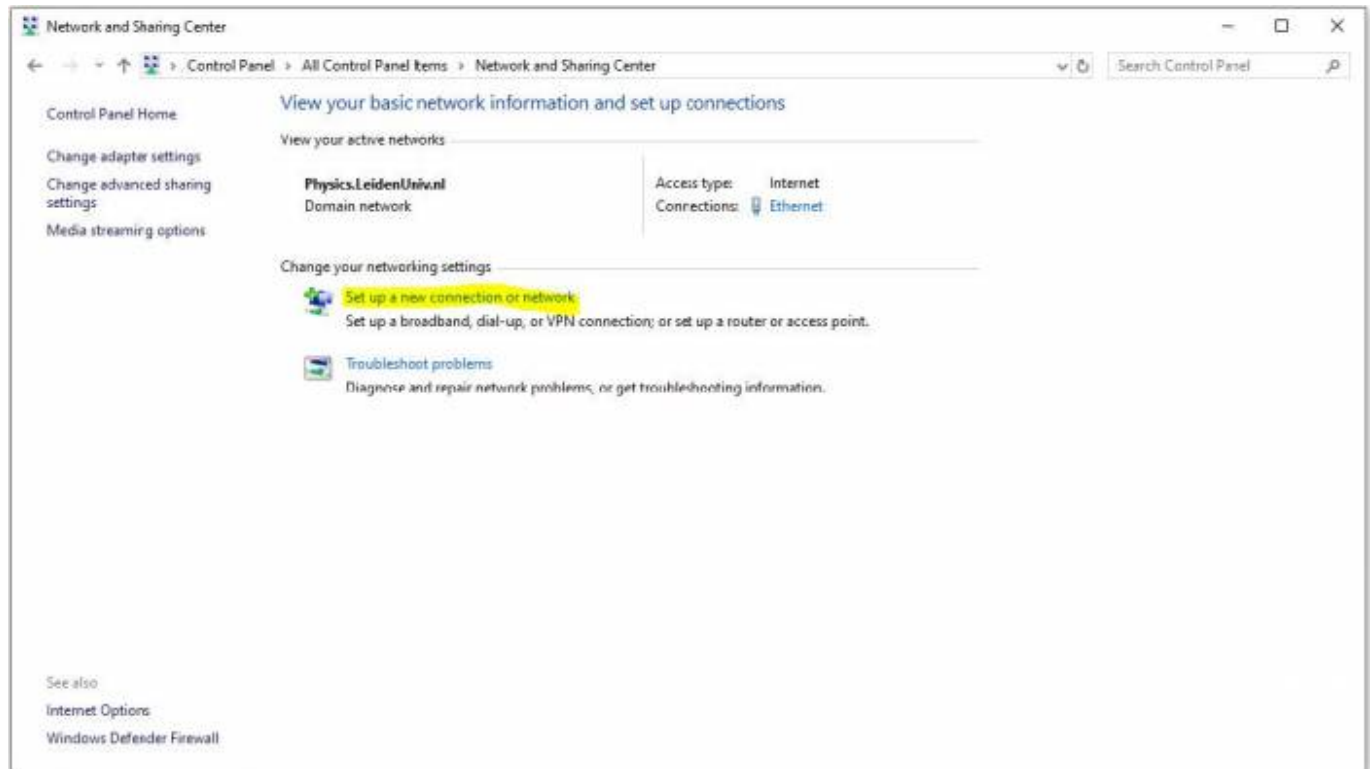


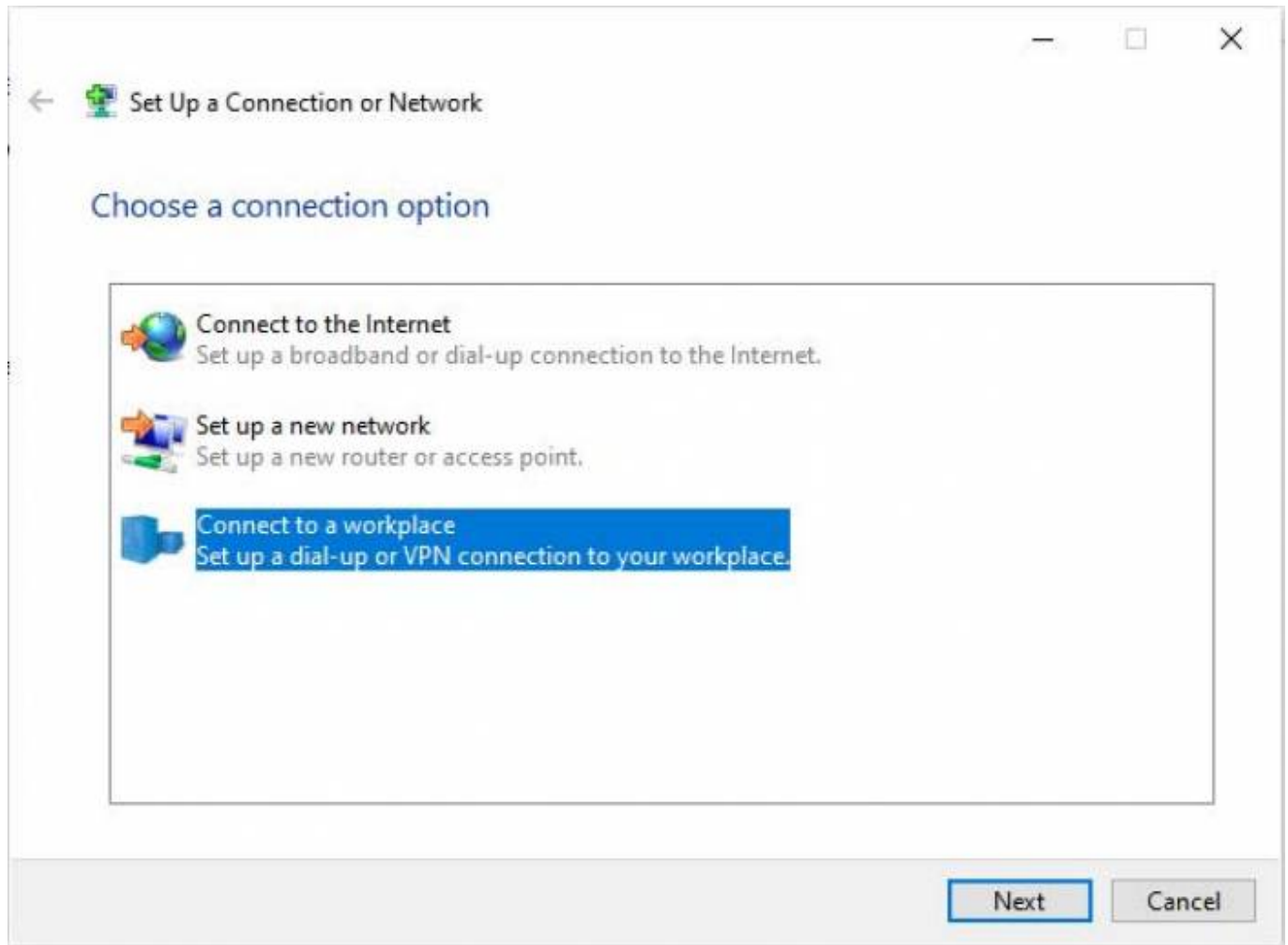
VPN Connection LION with DUO from Windows

Open Control Panel by typing control panel in the search bar

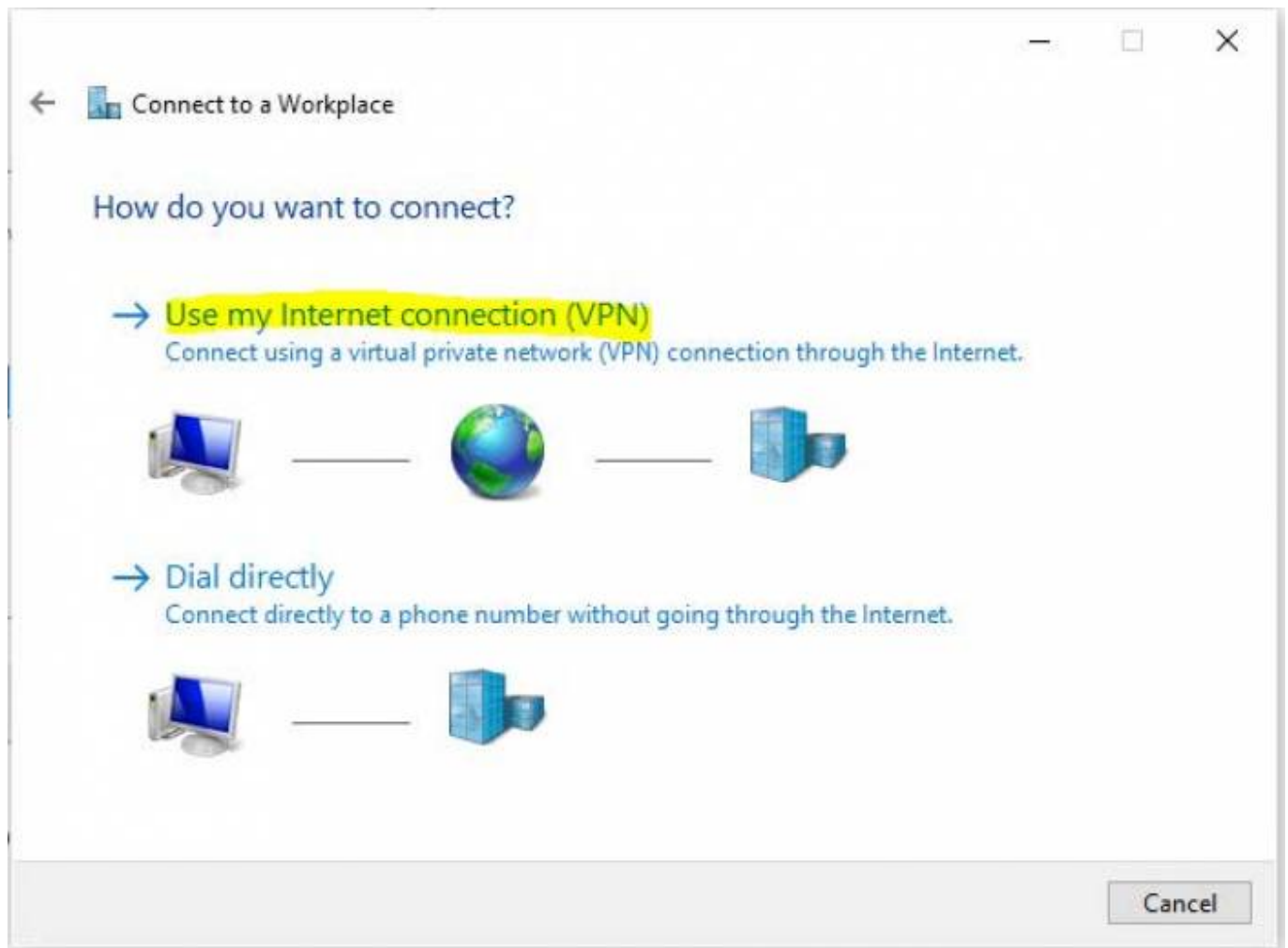

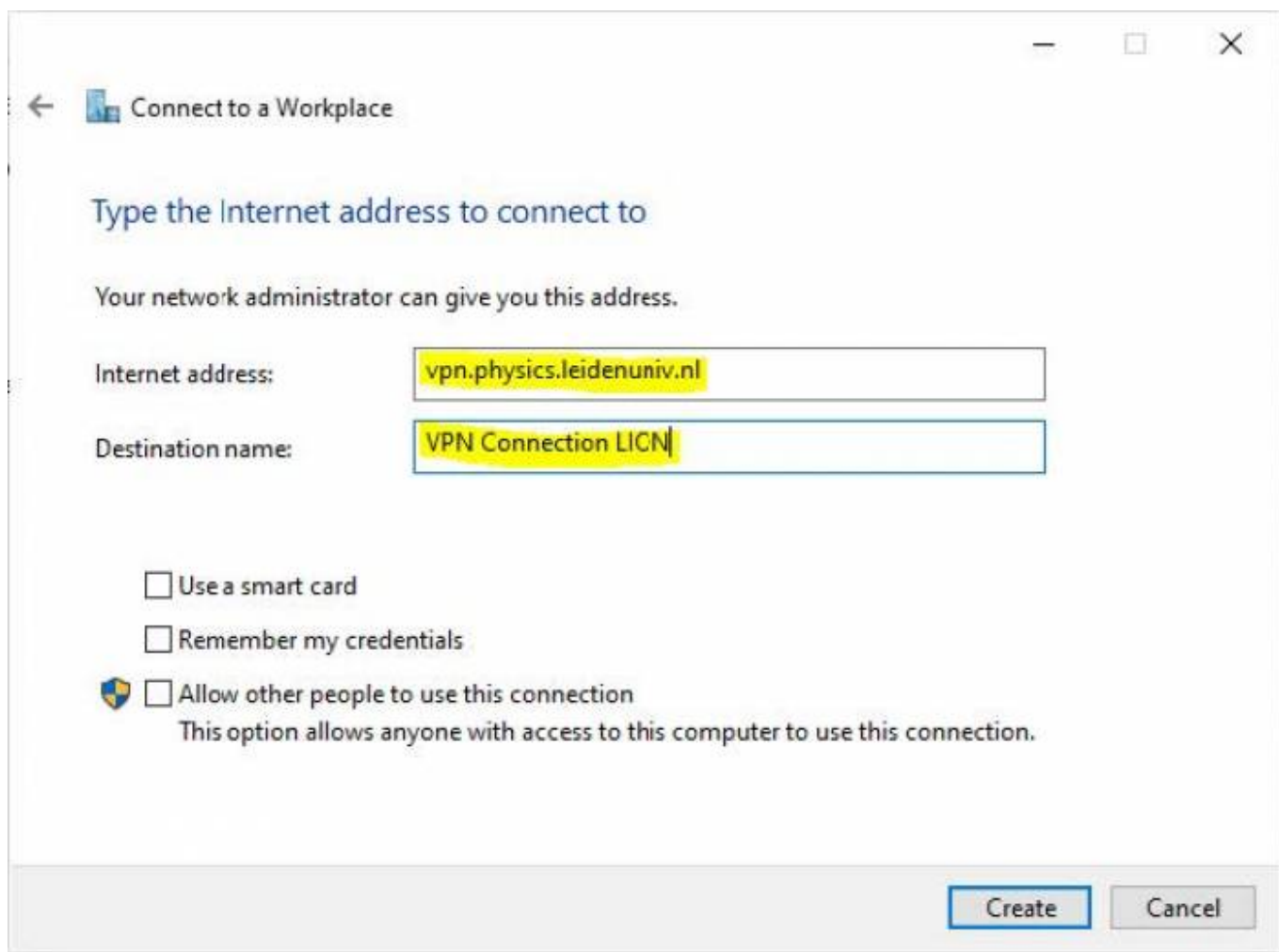
Click on "Set up a new connection or network"

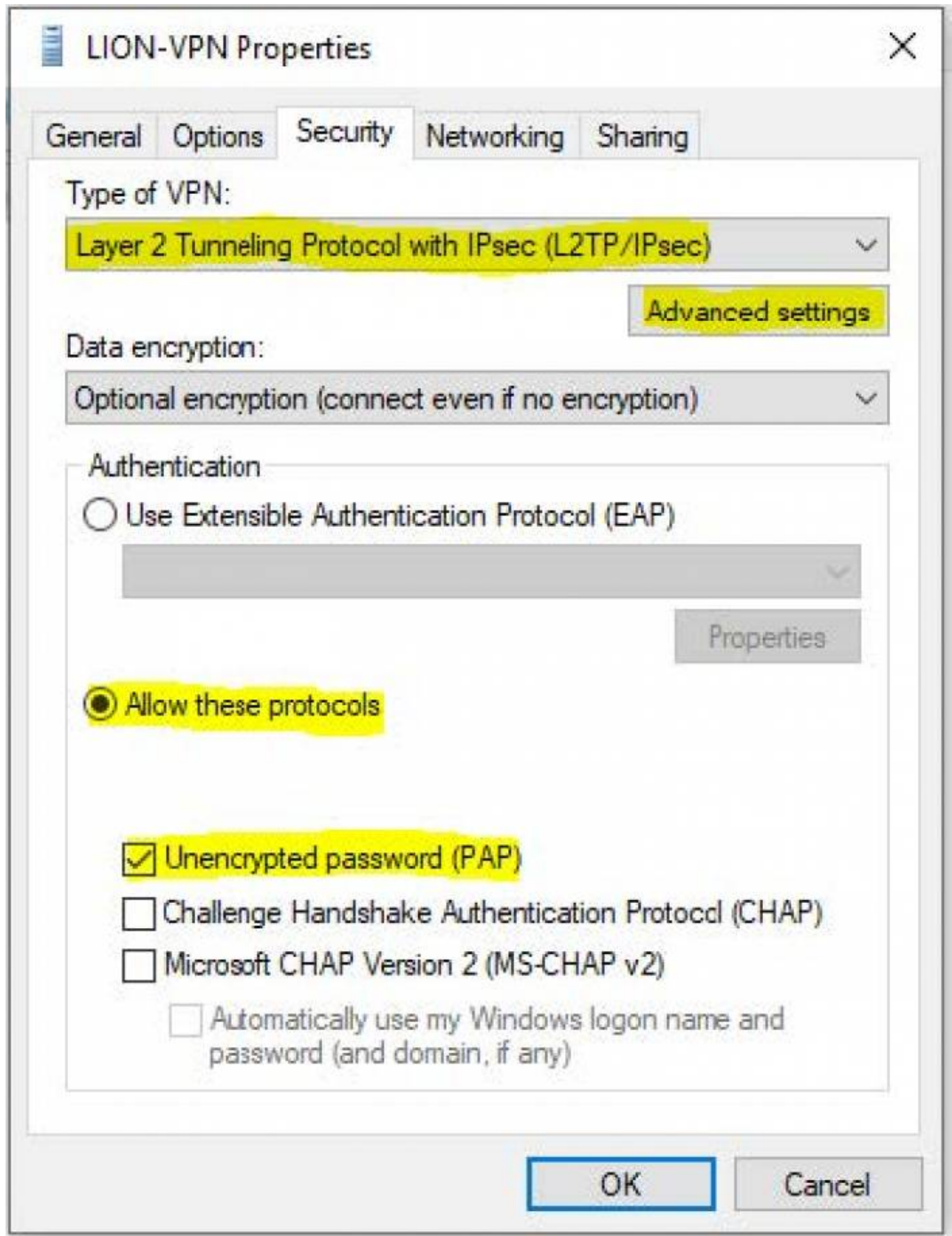

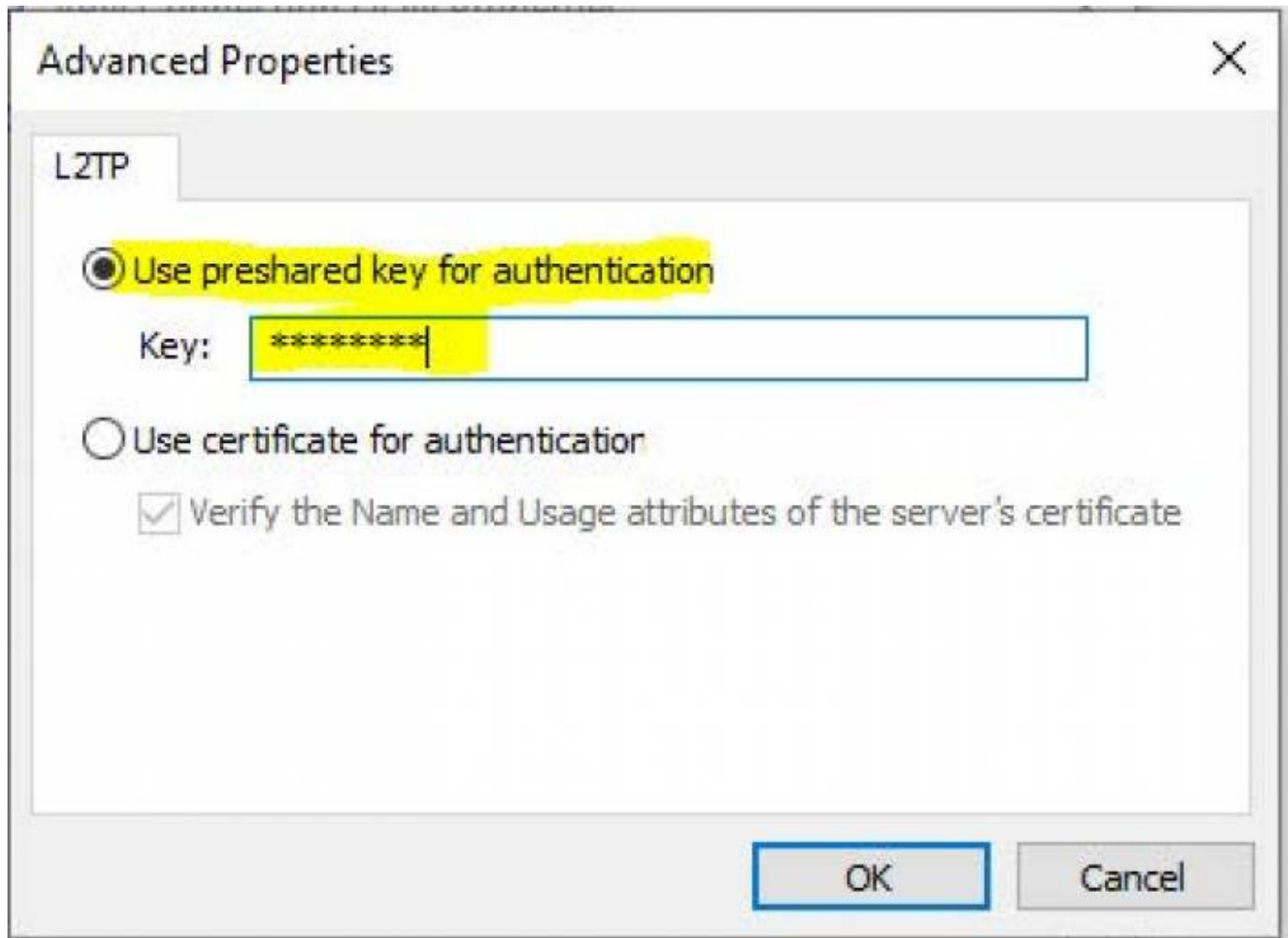

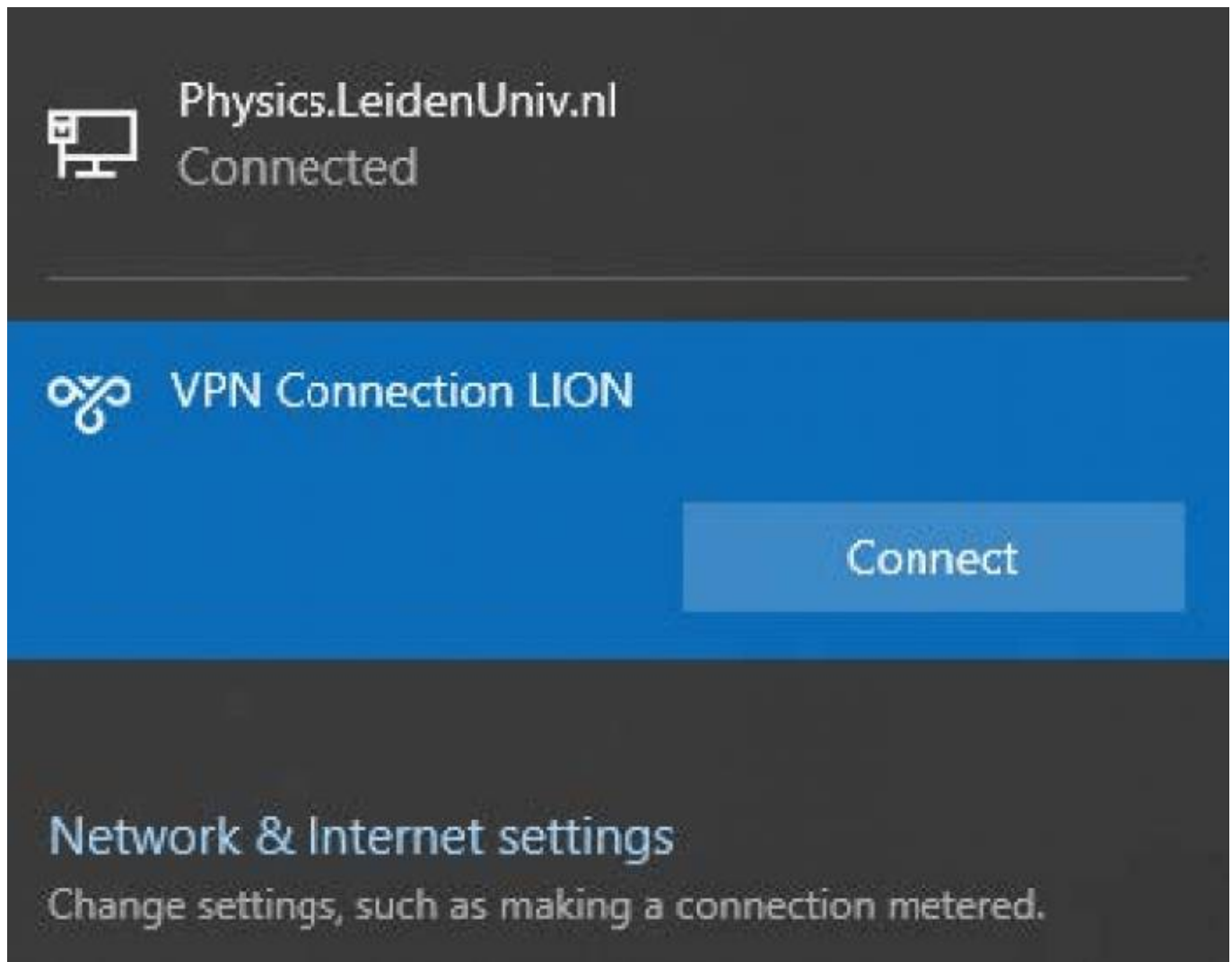
Select in the pulldown menu "Type of VPN" Layer 2 Tunneling Protocol with IPsec (L2TP/IPsec)
Then click Advanced settings



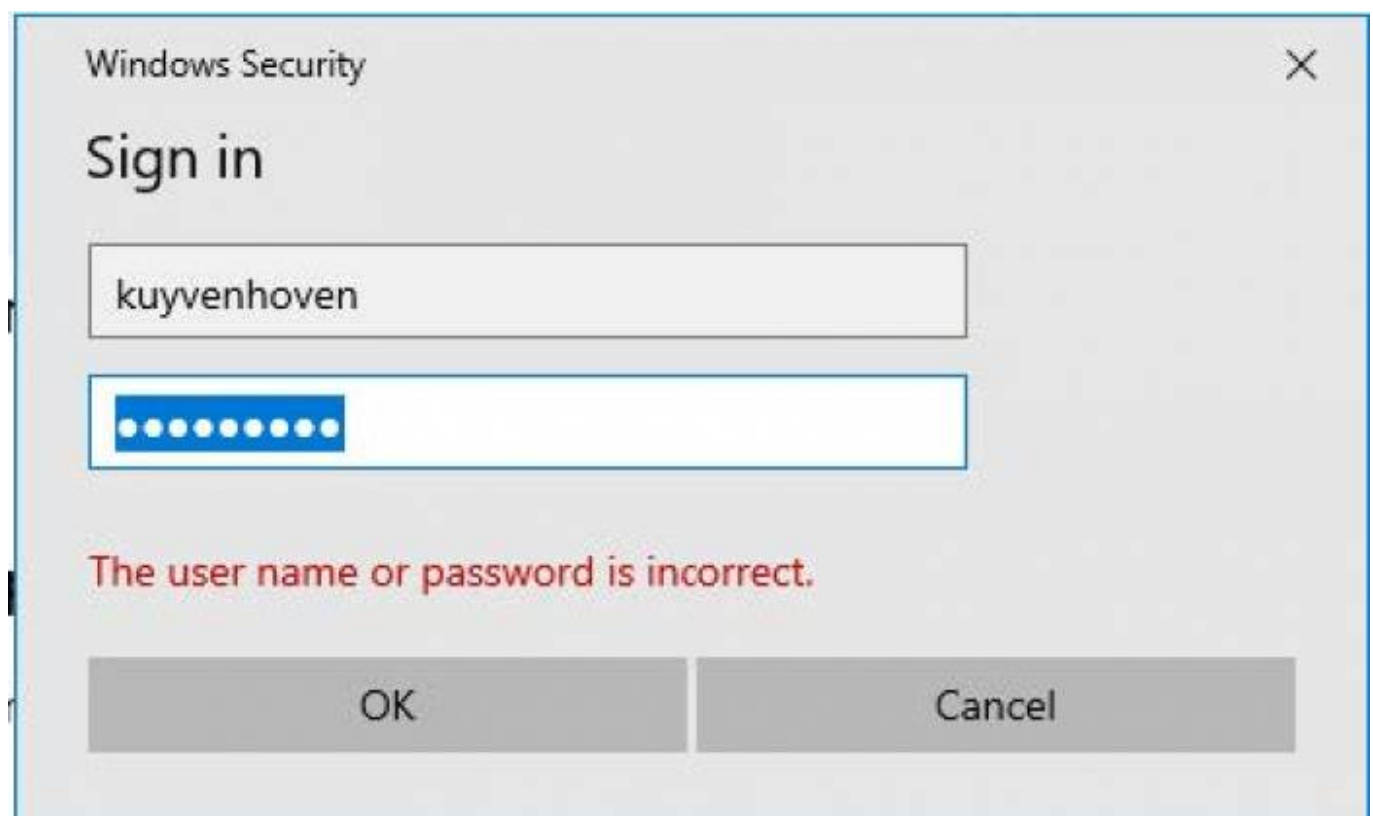
Select "Use preshared key for authentication"

If you wanted to use a Yubikey to authenticate instead of Duo Push , you should enter (don't forget the comma after your password):

```
username: bob  
password: *****,hold your finger on the yubikey
```
