Incoming server: mail.strw.leidenuniv.nl (protocol: IMAP, port 993, connection security: SSL/TLS. Authentication method: Normal password)

Outgoing server: mail.strw.leidenuniv.nl (port 465 or 587, SSL/TLS security. Authentication method: Normal password)

Some mail programs will call the authentication method by other names, such as “login” or “plain”.
